Description: Medallion style design with 37 inch center block consisting of Mariner's Compass with Broderie Perse style applique leaves and flowers surrounding it. Framed with 12 - 14 inch applique blocks in paper cut style motifs, straight set with 2.75 inch sashing strips between blocks. First border - .5 inch; second border - 1 inch; third border - .5 inch; fourth border - .75 inches; fifth border - 1.25 inches; sixth border - 1 inch.

Quilting Pattern: appliques are outline and detail quilted. Mariner's Compass points have feathers and leaves. Background fill of leaves and contoured lines with feathered wreaths around every other block. Borders are custom quilted with leaves, swirls and curves.

Finishing: 3/8 inch applied straight grain binding, machine front to hand back
